## Uniforms

The Pathfinder uniform is the most visible item of the Pathfinder program. It is worn to provide a sense of belonging to the international organization that stands for noble ideals and represents the Seventh-day Adventist youth of today.

Our club has two uniforms. Below describes each uniform and outlines when and where each uniform is to be worn.

### **DRESS UNIFORM:**

Tan Pathfinder shirt, black pants or skirt, black belt, black shoes, black socks (tan nylons are okay if wearing a skirt), black sash, scarf and slide.

The dress uniform is worn to all formal functions such as Pathfinder Sabbath, Induction, Investiture, Camporee, and Pathfinder Fair and other times as instructed by the director.

The dress uniform will also be required on the first Tuesday evening meeting of each month.

### **FIELD UNIFORM:**

Club t-shirt or sweatshirt with casual pants and shoes.

Field uniforms are worn at every weekly Tuesday meeting except the first Tuesday of each month. Also, the field uniform is worn at events such as Camporee and Fair.
