I desire to join the Cascade Eagles Pathfinder Club. I will attend club meetings, hikes, camping and field trips, fundraisers, missionary adventures and other club activities. I agree to be guided by the rules of the club and the Pathfinder Pledge and Law. I must be a Pathfinder in good standing and I will abide by the following:

Pathfinder Pledge

Pathfinder Law

1. Keep the morning watch
2. Do my honest part
3. Care for my body
4. Keep a level eye
5. Be courteous and obedient
6. Walk softly in the sanctuary
7. Keep a song in my heart
8. Go on God's errands

1. I understand that the Cascade Eagle Pathfinders have in place, the following disciplinary procedures and policies:
(NOTE: these will not necessarily be implemented in this order):
 - a. Verbal warning for bad behavior with name written on white board
 - b. If misconduct continues I will be asked to sit out of Pathfinder activities for a 15 minute time period and my parents and/or guardian will be notified of my misconduct.
 - c. I understand that if I have been given a 15 minute time out period at two Pathfinder meetings during the course of the Pathfinder year I will be asked to stay home for 1 Pathfinder meeting and miss any activities or events that occur during the following week.
 - d. I understand that if I am asked to miss two meetings during the course of the Pathfinder year due to my misconduct I may not be allowed to attend certain events and activities and may be asked to leave the club for the remainder of the year.
 - e. I understand that misconduct **includes but is not limited to**:
 - i. Repeatedly talking to staff members and fellow Pathfinders in a disrespectful tone;
 - ii. Repeatedly not following directions; repeatedly disrespecting fellow Pathfinder's and Staff's property and personal being by hitting, punching, kicking or harming myself, other Pathfinders or staff;
 - iii. Participating in illegal activities such as stealing, drinking and/or drug use;
 - iv. Leaving school property or the boundaries as set forth on Pathfinder outings without permission.
2. I will attend regular Pathfinder meetings, campouts and other events and participate in activities willingly and cheerfully.
3. I will not bring electronics to Pathfinder functions and if I do so I will be required to surrender the item(s) to staff for the duration of the event. Electronics include; **but are not limited to**: Cell phones; Game Boys/PSPs (portable gaming devices); Music/Video players (MP3, .wav, etc.); Radios, etc.
4. I will participate in as many Pathfinder functions and fundraising opportunities as I am able to and understand that this is required of all Pathfinders in order to raise funds for club activities. If I do not participate in fundraising activities I understand that I will not be credited any of the money collected during that fundraising event and will not be able to participate in future events that require fundraising, such as camporees, etc.
